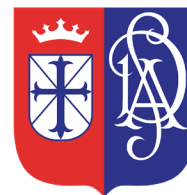

School History and Community

Saint Dominic Academy is an independent college preparatory school for young women. Established by the Sisters of Saint Dominic of Caldwell in 1878, the Academy is one of the oldest private secondary schools in New Jersey. Its one square mile campus is located in Jersey City, New Jersey's second largest city, right across the river from Manhattan. The Academy's student body mirrors the diversity of Hudson County - which boasts one of the most international populations in the country. At Saint Dominic Academy, students represent countries from every continent. The school community is a special place where girls of different races, nationalities and creeds learn to embrace cultural differences in a universal sisterhood (20% Asian; 15% African American; 30% Hispanic; 35% Caucasian). As a "Peaceable School" the Academy promotes unity through an environment where every student's intrinsic worth is recognized and respected by all. Students come to Saint Dominic Academy from throughout Hudson County, and parts of Essex, Bergen and beyond. They come mostly by bus and train, learning how to navigate the distance from home to school with the confidence and energy of true "urbanistas". SDA's 5,000 living alumnae can be found in every walk of life, from the financial wizard who headed the Global Management Group for Morgan Stanley, to the pediatrician who volunteers at a homeless shelter. They are partners in major accounting firms, federal judges, university administrators, poets, politicians, teachers, nurses and entrepreneurs.

Admissions

The Academy is recognized for its outstanding academics, as a competitive, college preparatory, four-year high school for highly motivated young women. All of them are expected to go on to higher education after completing the rigorous program the Academy offers. The graduation rate is typically 100%, despite the challenging circumstances many students encounter in their daily lives. Students are accepted on the basis of the Archdiocesan Cooperative Exam, school records and teacher recommendations.

Faculty

Saint Dominic Academy has a faculty of 25 of which over 70% are holding advanced degrees. A member of the Dominican Sisters of Caldwell is on the senior administration team. Two professional counselors are on staff to support student needs.

DUAL-ENROLLMENT

SDA students with a 3.0 GPA or above are given the opportunity to take college courses for credit during their elective period (if scheduling allows) during their senior year at Saint Peter's University. SDA's partnership with Seton Hall University allows students to earn college credits at a reduced rate when successfully completing AP Psychology, AP US History, & AP Art History. In partnership with Caldwell University, a grade of at least "3" in the following AP examinations can be transferred as college credit: Calculus, Chemistry, English, Spanish, US History, US Government, and Psychology
